Over the past several years, Huntington Learning Center has provided valuable academic support to CCPS schools, particularly those identified as Title I and ATSI. Through extended learning opportunities during the school day, Huntington has delivered high-quality tutoring in reading and math to elementary, middle, and high school students.

Tutors from Huntington have supported Multilingual Learners at Thomas Stone High School, providing essential instruction in language, English Language Arts, and Math in preparation for high school assessments required for graduation. At Somers Middle School, tutors have supported students with special needs by addressing learning gaps and reinforcing grade-level skills. At Smallwood Middle School, a dedicated tutor has led small group reading interventions focused on foundational literacy skills in the reading labs. Similarly, J.C. Parks, J.P. Ryon, and Jenifer Elementary Schools have benefited from Huntington tutors who work three days a week with small groups of five students, targeting reading and math deficits to help close achievement gaps.

Brandy Merriman, representing Huntington Learning Center, has been an invaluable partner in coordinating and delivering these services. Her responsiveness and commitment ensure that tutors are consistently available, services are uninterrupted, and communication remains strong between the Learning Center, Central Office, and school teams.
