## Frequently Asked Questions

### How do I know if Micro school is a good fit for my child?

- A micro school setting is the right fit for your child if you are looking for a better alternative to homeschooling but with the structure of a private school. Micro School Powered by Huntington Learning Center has a small class size to ensure students are not overwhelmed while learning the foundational skills on core subjects like math, reading, writing, science and social studies.

### What grade levels do you serve?

- The microschool serves students in Kindergarten through Grade 8, with flexibility based on location and enrollment.

### What subjects are taught?

- Students receive instruction in all core academic areas, including: Reading/English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies
- All instruction aligns with state learning standards and is delivered through a blended model that combines direct instruction, Huntington methodology, and digital learning tools.

### Do you support students with learning differences?

- Yes. The micro school provides targeted academic interventions and supports, and offers accommodations aligned with IEP or 504 guidance when appropriate. Our goal is to help every student make meaningful progress.

### Is Micro School powered by Huntington Learning Center accredited?

- Yes, our micro school is accredited by the Middle States Association. This provides extra peace of mind for parents and assurance of keeping high-quality academic standards.

### How do you measure student progress?

- Student growth is monitored through ongoing classroom assessments and standardized tools, including the Renaissance Star Assessment for Reading and Mathematics. Families receive progress reports every nine weeks, along with scheduled parent teacher conferences twice each year.

### How small are your classes?

- Class sizes are intentionally kept small, with a 6:1 student to teacher ratio. This allows educators to provide focused attention, targeted support, and meaningful feedback.

### Do you offer enrichment opportunities?

- Yes. In addition to core academics, students benefit from enrichment offerings such as study skills and executive functioning programs, homework workshops, and academic extensions designed to support long term success.
